TAMBURO just sold two battery-operated razors and ship's wheel clock to PAGLIARULO. and later on..... *he did!*

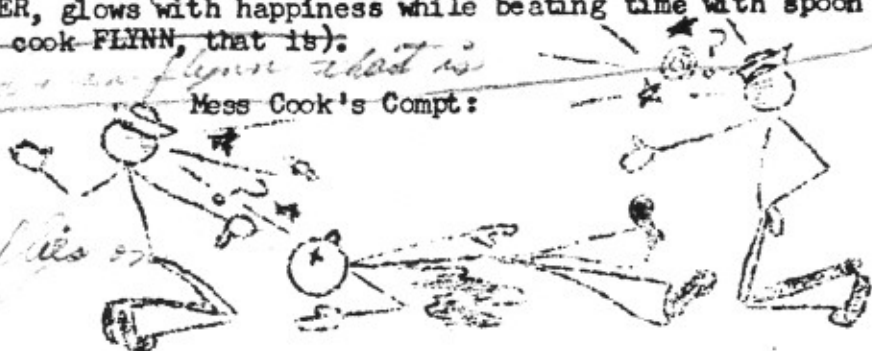
Mess Decks:
